

Greater Kirkland Area Chamber Scholarship

Due Date: Thursday, April 26, 2019

Amount: \$1,000.00

Scholarship will be paid in one installment at the time of High School graduation and determination of successful enrollment in a training program to start in the Fall of 2019 Academic year. This scholarship will be given to a graduating Senior from Hiawatha High School who is interested in pursuing an education in accounting, business, marketing, sales and/or technology through a two-year associate program or a four-year degree program.

Criteria:

1. Hiawatha High School graduating senior.
2. Upper 40% of the graduating class.
3. Consideration will be given to the following criteria: Interest in business and other mentioned training fields, demonstrating leadership in a variety of settings, participation in school and community activities, and good citizenship.
4. Financial need is not a prerequisite, but a consideration. A primary intention of this scholarship is to reward top scholars of their accomplishments he or she attained for himself or herself during their high school years.
5. An essay to be added on a separate sheet of paper(s) with no more than 500 words on the topic: In what manners will this scholarship aid you in achieving your educational goals now and in the future?
6. Personal interview may be required as the final step in the selection process for this scholarship.
7. You must put your name and the scholarship name on each page of the scholarship form and this cover sheet will be considered the first page of the application process.
8. The Student Data Form must be the second page of the application for the scholarship. Additional pages maybe added for School related activities and offices held; community and past church activities and offices held; as well as past and present work experience. Your essay response should be put on a separate page(s).
9. **Submit Completed Scholarship Application to High School Counselor on or before Thursday, April 26, 2019.**
