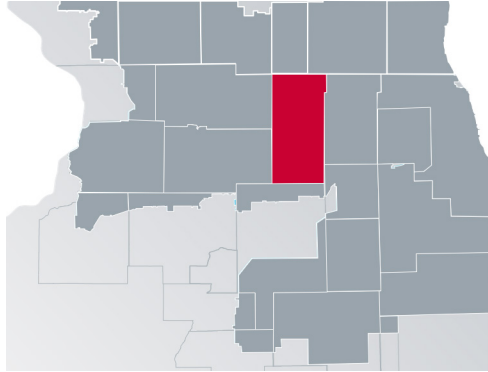


DEKALB COUNTY SUSTAINABLE ENERGY SUCCESS
