## DeKalb Data Center DeKalb, IL



Curran Contracting is currently performing site work for Mortenson Construction for a future data center for a high profile social media end user. The data center will be occupying 505 acres of a 1,000-acre park. The scope of work includes preliminary site work portion of the project and infrastructure of the facility. Over 1,000,000 cubic yards of dirt will be moved and over 300,000 tons of aggregate will be placed during this phase. This 907,000-square-foot data center, will support over 100 operational jobs and hundreds of construction jobs in the DeKalb County area.

New signals and striping provide additional capacity for traffic along Randall Road and a safer driving experience for all motorists.
